The New Year is almost here – a time to reflect over the last twelve months. In June the Board of Directors set aside \$20,000 for our first round of Grant Awards. The purpose of the Foundation is to provide funds to women who would benefit from fertility treatments but who cannot afford them. Since the maximum Grant is \$5,000, the Applicants must assume the balance of the cost themselves.

We are very happy that, due to the generosity of many caring individuals, the **Evan David Foundation has been able to award two Grants in 2012!!** Both Grants were awarded to assist women with the costs of in vitro fertilization –also known as IVF. We will know in a few months if their fertility treatments led to a successful pregnancy!

Our goal for 2013 is to provide financial assistance for 4 or 5 additional women to receive fertility treatments. This means we need your help!!
